OUR School

Background Statement and History

Mondeor Eco School opened its doors on 15 January 2007. It started as a small home school with only four learners and one teacher. By the end of the first term there were ten learners enrolled. The owners then bought the current premises and re-opened its doors in May 2007.

During the first year the school functioned in phases rather than in classes per grade as the number of learners were too small, and the learners were all in different grades. In 2008 there were thirty learners and one class per grade. In 2009 there were 78 enrolled learners. We also now had a teacher per class in the Primary School, as well as for Grade 8 and 9. The High School from Grade 10 – 12 had a qualified teacher per subject.

The school was initially started as there was a need for small class teaching where learners could receive individual attention on a one-to-one basis. At the same time the need for a less stressful environment for children that struggled in the mainstream schools was created. The owners had the idea to create a farm environment and to use nature and animals in the development of the learners. This also fulfilled a specific need in the school market for a more holistic approach to teaching.

The school is owned by the director Freddy Goss and is governed by a well-qualified and able management team. Together the members of the management team have fifty years of experience in working with children, making them skilled and equipped to manage the school. The teachers are also well qualified and committed to the learning process and the vision of the school. Together these two teams form a stable and strong foundation for the future growth of Mondeor Eco School.

Academics

Eco Buddyz: 2-4 years & Grade RR

Eco Buddyz is a safe and nurturing environment where we work together to support every aspect of development in each child as an individual.

Primary School: Grade R -7

We follow the CAPS (Curriculum Assessment Policy Statement) as prescribed by the Western Cape Education Department. Our class groups are a maximum of 16. The teacher focuses on celebrating each child and addresses the child's specific needs. Additionally, we offer music appreciation, isiXhosa in Grade R-3 and an introduction to Coding and Robotics.

High School:

We follow the South African National curriculum (CAPS) as prescribed by the Western Cape Education Department. Our learners receive a National Senior Certificate (NSC) at the end of their Grade 12 year, accredited by UMALUSI. We are registered as an Examination Centre at the Western Cape Education Department and the Gr. 12 NSC examination is written at our school.

School of Skills:

Mondeor Eco School of Skills provides learners who have had difficulty in a mainstream academic context with an alternative educational setting more conducive to their specific needs and learning abilities. We foster an environment, for learners that promote self-discipline and motivation and assists students in developing skills to become economically independent and self-sufficient adults who will succeed in the workplace and contribute responsibly to the community.

The Mondeor Eco School of Skills' curriculum is a four-year educational track that is dually focused on academic learning and vocational training. Learners receive a comprehensive education in all traditional academic subject areas – Afrikaans, English, Creative Arts, Mathematics, Natural Science, Personal and Social Wellbeing, and Physical Education – at an Intermediate Phase level. We follow the South African National adapted curriculum as prescribed by the Western Cape Education Department. Our learners receive a WCED Skills Certificate at the end of their 4th year.

Enrolment procedure

The following procedure needs to be followed for enrolment:

- * An informational meeting is to be scheduled between the parent and principal of the school.
- * The parent/guardian must complete the admission form fully with all attached documents and hand it in at reception prior to the booking of the window period.
- * The learner visits the school for a 3-day window period at no charge.
- * A meeting with the parents will follow the window period to give feedback.
- * A letter will then be given to the parents/guardian stating whether the application was successful or not and stating the date of admission.
- * The deposit must be settled in full, and the admission form must be handed in before the learner will be allowed to attend class.

With admission the following will be discussed and handed to the parents as well as the learner:

COLLECTION OF SCHOOL FEES

School fees must be paid on or before the first day of each month. Should the fees due or any part thereof remain in arrears by the 8th day of the month, we reserve the right to terminate the contract and refuse the student access to the school as set out below (refer to "Take Note" table below).

We also reserve the right to charge collection fees and interest. You will however still be responsible for payment of the particular month as well as the following month, which should be seen as the notice month.

NOTICE PERIOD

One calendar month's written notice is required should you wish to terminate your child's attendance and may be subject to a cancellation fee.

Take note

In the event where school fees are in arrears, a written notification will be sent to the scholar's parents/guardians. If such account remains in arrears for a period of twenty business days after receiving such notification, the contract between the school and the scholar's parents/guardians will be regarded as terminated due to breach of contract and the scholar will be requested to leave the premises and will be barred from attending further classes.

PAYMENT OPTIONS FOR SCHOOL FEES

- Single payment by 30 November 2023 (Early payment discount of 10%)

Note: If paying for a year in advance making use of the discount for once-off payments no money shall be refunded if classes are terminated or a student is expelled.

ADDITIONAL COSTS THAT WILL BE RECOVERED FROM PARENTS

- Any special arrangement that needs to be made (for example: transcriber for examinations and/or any other special service that your child may require).
- Damages suffered by the school due to the negligence of students.
- Any extra cost involved with educational visits, for example entrance fees and transport.
- Once a scholar has tested positive for any substance, it will be the responsibility of the parent(s) to produce a negative test result in respect of such scholar from a pathology laboratory for that substance every second week. This does not preclude the school from testing as well. R100 will be charged for every positive drug test performed by the school.

NON-PAYING PARENTS/GUARDIANS

If any portion of the total amount of school fees that is payable in terms of a specific payment plan is not paid on or before the specified date, the full outstanding amount of the annual school fees will become due and payable and legal action may be taken. The parent/guardian will be held liable for any outstanding amounts on behalf of their minor child. Mondeor Eco School (Pty) Ltd reserves the right to apply to an appropriate court for an order claiming all outstanding fees and all collection and/or attorney expenses on an Attorney and Client Scale.
